F I R E P L A C E H E A R T H S

Hearths have been at the heart of our homes for hundreds of years. The place where your fire will sit, it offers warmth and safe place to cosy up around. Purchasing the right hearth is essential, not only are there a few important safety regulations you have to take into consideration, but you want to find one that looks good too.

Design and non-combustible material is the blueprint for any fireplace hearth design.

Create a luxe yet practical look for your fireplace with a concrete fireplace hearth and surround. There are various creative ways to use concrete as a hearth alternative whilst making a feature point in providing colour and texture to the space.

Transform this space of your home to a modern, warm and pleasant sanctuary.





F E A T U R E S

When considering concrete as a fireplace hearth and surround alternative, there are some great features not all clients are aware of, these include:

- All of our fireplace hearths and surrounds can be completely custom made to suit your fireplace requirements. This includes the overall length, width and thickness
- Our GFRC (Glass Fibre Reinforced Concrete) Fireplace Hearths are available in many colours
 - GFRC is made from non combustible materials
 - Our GFRC Fireplace Hearths can appear floating sitting under your fireplace
 - Our GFRC Fireplace Hearths are perfect for gas, wood and electric fireplaces
- In terms of pricing, thickness doesn't effect our pricing much at all. We have three pricing brackets, the first being 20mm-25mm, the second being 30mm-80mm and the third being 90mm+. Whether your hearth is 40mm thick or 80mm thick, this thickness will not impact your Quote.
- Clients can be concerned about additional reinforcement in their floors, however there is no need to be concerned when it come to our Fireplace Harths. As we specialise in GFRC, it is a third of the weight of standard concrete.
- We can achieve oversized, large fireplace hearths in one piece, meaning no joins. The size that can be achieved is determined on a case-by-case basis.

O U R P R O C E S S

STEP 1: Email us a copy of your plans or a drawing of your proposed design/layout. It is best for this to include the length, width and preferred thickness of each piece (if there are multiple). At this time, let us know if it will be floating too. From here, we will be able to send you an initial Quote to give you an indication of price. Also include your address for delivery and installation, including any information we may need to know about access (stairs, steep driveway, narrow entrance etc).

STEP 2: If the initial Quote is something you may be interested in, we would recommend you make an appointment to come in and see us. During your appointment, we can discuss the project further, discuss the product, check out colours and samples and the projects we are currently working on.

STEP 3: If you decide to proceed, it's best you keep us in the loop in terms of timeframe so we can keep the project in our pipeline and temporarily book in a final measure and site visit (if required).

STEP 4: Once all details have been confirmed (size, colour etc), we are ready to get started.

STEP 5: We will make the formwork for the project, cast the project, process it and seal it. For this stage, we will need at least 7-10 days for this process.

STEP 6: We will keep in touch during this process and once sealing is underway, we will be in touch to arrange a day and time for delivery and installation. Depending on the current workload at the time, we usually ask our clients to allow 3-5 weeks from confirmation to installation, however, as I mention above we only need 7-10 days to create your project.

STEP 7: We are ready for installation. As for you, sit back, relax, and admire!



C O L O U R S & F I N I S H E S

At Mitchell Bink Concrete Design we offer a range of colours and finishes to our clients.

Our specialised mix starts with pure white cement, we then add black or coloured oxide to achieve different shades and colours. We offer a set range of colours (image 1-10 below) however any colour can be achieved through a custom sample process (if required). All grey colours can have a warm (image 9 & 10 below) or cool (image 1-8 below) tone.


Most projects are white, grey or black, but we certainly offer colours like pink, blue and green to name a few. At Mitchell Bink Concrete Design, we offer three different Finishes:

CREAM FINISH: This Finish is created by using a spraying technique. It is clean and crisp with slight texture.

MB SIGNATURE RANGE: This Finish is achieved by hand pressing concrete into our formwork. This Finish provides more movement and texture. This Finish can be achieved in any of the colours below.

TROWELED FINISH: This Finish is used for projects like stair treads and landings. It is hand troweled to give a raw textured look. This Finish is only used for certain projects.




